

Our **ENGLISH** lessons will guide us through a visit into the past, experiencing the Industrial Revolution through the eyes of Smith, a 12-year-old pickpocket. We will be reading and writing stories and fictional diaries from an historical perspective.

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In **MATHS** we will be looking at Place Value in greater depth and begin our journey towards solving multi-step problems involving all four operations.

In **GEOGRAPHY** and **HISTORY** we will also be looking at how the UK's ever-shifting physical landscape has changed alongside its increasingly diverse population, as well as how our country has progressed because of the Industrial Revolution.



In **ART** we will be comparing and contrasting the works of John Constable and William Turner and attempting to emulate particular techniques they utilised in their paintings. In **DT** we will begin studying notable inventors from the 18th Century onward.

Our **SCIENCE** lessons will involve investigating various materials, both natural and manufactured. We will get to know their properties through a series of interactive experiments, and put more effort into using our Key Stage 2 English skills when recording our observations.
