In our **English** lessons, we will be reading 'The Magic Paintbrush' and our focus will be on description. We will also be writing diaries, having read Samuel Pepys' diary from the Fire of London.

In History, we will be learning about the Great Fire of London. We will learn about how the fire started, how it spread, and how actions have been taken to prevent it happening again. We will also learn about Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot.

In **D&T** we will be making and evaluating bread. We will also produce art for our display.

In **PSHE** we will be learning about fire safety.

In **maths** we will be looking at using place value, the 4 operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division), shape and money.

Our **science** lessons will be a continuation of our learning of materials so far. We will put our knowledge to the test and experiment the suitability of materials for different purposes.
