English

In English, year 1/2 will be reading Finding Nemo and looking at the order of events in the story. They will be retelling the story of Finding Nemo and writing character and setting descriptions.

The children will be writing poems based on the sea, using their descriptive writing to support them. They will also be writing a recount on their trip to the beach.

Maths

In Maths, year 1/2 will be looking at a variety of areas including: volume, mass, capacity, measurement, shape and the four operations.

The children will begin comparing capacities of water, using resources to support them with this.

They will also be discussing appropriate units of measure.

Science

In Science, we will be looking at living things and their habitats. Relating this to our topic; finding out about sea creatures and habitats under the sea.

Geography

Our topic this term is Under the sea, to start we will be creating an under the sea display. We will be identifying different creatures and discussing different oceans around the world.

Spanish

In Spanish, year 1/2 will be learning vocabulary relating to under the sea and practising saying this words with fluency and accent.

Art/Design Technology

In Art, the children will be creating sand art and investigating making waves.

RE/PSHE

In RE, year 1/2 will be looking at special words and stories, (we will begin looking at symbols of wind).

We will also be looking at relationships within PSHE.

PE

In PE, year 1/2 will be investigating attacking and defending skills. Looking at strategies and working as a team in games.

Computing

In computing, the children will use logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programs.

Music

In music, year 1/2 will be learning and practising hymns.
