

Year 1 and 2 - Transport



English Year 1- Our first literacy tasks will be to write a recount of events. Then we will be looking at creative writing based around the story 'Oi! Get Off My Train!'

Year 2 - Our first literacy tasks will be based around the Scorpion and the Frog. Then we will be joining Year 1 with the story ' Oi! Get Off My Train!'

Maths - We will be learning about sequencing, place value, addition and subtraction. There will be opportunities for us to use these skills across the curriculum.

Art - We will be using different media to print different modes of transport.

Geography – We will be looking at transport within our local area.

Science - We will be looking at different materials and linking this to D.T.

History - We will be focusing on how transport has evolved through the ages.

PE - We will be working on throwing and catching of different balls in sports. We will also be working competitively in teams.

Homework – This will be handed out every Friday in the booklet and due in on the following Thursday. Children can complete the work in space in the booklet or on a separate piece of paper which can be pinned up on our 'Work to Bee Proud Of' wall.

Reading – Please read as much as possible with your child at home and leave comments in their reading diaries. Children are expected to change their books once a week and read to an adult once a week independently. Children also read to an adult every day in Phonics.

RE - We will explore the question, what is God like?

Spanish - We will be learning greetings and numbers.

Computing - We will be learning how to use technology safely.
