

FROZEN!

- Stunning start: Film afternoon of Frozen
- Magical middle: We will be taking aeroplanes to faraway places and producing a weather report
 - Fantastic finale: We will be creating an ice palace

ENGLISH

We will be reading 'The Snow Queen' and then we will be writing a weather report on a frozen place. We will be looking at poetry along the theme of weather and information texts about weather.

Grammar & punctuation: We will revise the terms verb, adverb, adjective & complex sentences as well as looking at the language feature of poetry. This will include rhyme, using specific words for purpose and using phonic knowledge to help with spellings.

RE: We will be learning about Christmas and its origins. This will tie in with our Christianity studies and the school ethos.

PE:

We will be learning the skills needed for attacking and defending games. This will take part outdoors, weather permitting. Please ensure your child has their PE kit at school for our Monday lesson.

BRITISH VALUES

We will be focussing on individual rights and responsibilities as well as respecting peoples' beliefs and customs from multiple cultures. This will tie in with Kipling stories.

MUSIC: We will learn a song that celebrates South African music and investigate pulse, rhythm & pitch through listening games and appraising games, singing & playing instruments.

ART AND D&T: We will be designing and making aeroplanes to fly to frozen places. This follows on from our learning last term about transport and links with our Geography and Science.

SCIENCE: We will be looking at seasonal changes and how these changes occur. We will observe changes across the four seasons and look at features of the seasons. We will focus on the weather associated with each season and how the day lengths vary. These lessons will include looking at light and shadows.

MATHS

Y1& Y2: We will be looking at a range of topics including doubling and halving, addition and subtraction, mentally solving addition and subtraction and shape and data.

As part of our learning we will be looking at strategies to solve addition and subtraction problems and how these can be used to solve some problems mentally.

We will introduce Carroll and Venn diagrams as a means for classifying shapes and to help us to highlight similarities and differences

Y2: We will begin to look at multiplication using different methods to help us understand groups of objects and numbers.

PSHE: Our topic is relationships and we will look at good and bad relationships in relation to the books we are reading. This is expanded upon in relation to 'friends' and we investigate what makes a good friend and how we can be good friends to others.

GEOGRAPHY: Linked with science, we will be looking at different locations and their weather. We will be studying cold climates and the seasonal changes in these places compared to Terling.
