

Year 3 and 4 Time Quest

You're Here!*

When we first come back to school we are going to have a 'mini topic' which is called "You're Here!". This will focus on our learning behaviours and how to be a successful learner. We will be looking at the story called Giraffes Can't Dance to help us with this.

In English we will be using the Horrid Henry books to write stories based in a familiar setting.

If you have any of these books you would like to bring in to help you then please feel free – just remember to put your name in them!

In Maths we will be looking at the place value of numbers, addition and subtraction methods.

In English we shall learn how to write instructions to go with the game we are inventing for Reception. We will also write some humorous poetry; so be prepared to hear silly rhymes and nonsense words at home!

In maths we will continue to look at addition and subtraction methods. We will also be practising the times tables and the corresponding division facts.

In Science, we will be looking at animal and human bodies – including the skeletons and digestive systems.

In History we will be learning about the change in leisure time and T.V since World War Two, we will also watch some Muffin the Mule and compare him with a modern day T.V character.

In Computing, we will learn how to save, edit and enhance photographs and images.

Homework: You will receive a homework booklet that has all the homework for the up and coming half term. Homework is due in every Thursday. Please encourage your child to hand in their homework on time.

PE: Generally our P.E days will be Thursday. Please make sure that your child has their full P.E kit every day though – days may change depending on the weather!
