Our Topic

This Romans unit is all about the impact the Roman Empire had on life in Britain. We will learn about the rise of the Roman Empire, the invasion of Britain and the eventual conquest. We will also look in detail at some aspects of the Romanisation of Britain, such as the building of Roman roads and baths house. In addition to this we will have the opportunity to learn about the British resistance of Boudicca and will act in role to look at the events of Boudicca's rebellion from different perspectives.

In English, we will be learning the Roman myth of Romulus and Remus. We will write our own Mythical stories. We will also write a newspaper article about the Roman invasion.

In Maths, we will be looking at fractions and decimals. We will be looking at fractions and working out which fractions and decimals are equivalent.
