

# Year 3 and 4

## Water



### Our Topic

This unit on Water introduces children to the changes of state and allows them to explore the processes of evaporation and condensation through a range of practical activities. We will also be looking at habitats located in and around water. Our topic is very Science and Geography based so we will be having lots of cross-curricular lessons. By considering water as a finite resource, the children are introduced to the ideas of conservation and consider some of the issues surrounding supplying clean drinking water to a growing global population

In English, we will be learning about non-fiction texts. We will be using our reading skills to research different topics and present our information in different ways. We will also be writing traditional poems about water.

In Maths, we will be looking at money and statistics. We will be looking at how to add and subtract money as well as solving problems based on money. In statistics, we will be learning to collect, present and interpret data.

In R.E, we will be learning about Islam and Pentecost.
