

**British Values:**

We will be focussing on the behaviour skills we have learnt through 'Moving On Up' and will record how these fit with the remit of British Values. This will include taking part in several activities and debating their purpose as a class.

**P.E:**

We will this half term, start our Cricket and Rounders section of the curriculum. These sports encourage the children to work on individual skills and techniques, developing the control they have for themselves and the equipment and then applying these in small and then larger groups.

**Art / Design Technology:**

We will be planning, designing and creating a healthy balanced diet. This will link in particular to Science and PSHE and the effects that certain foods and energy have on the body.

**Computing:**

The children will be presenting their research on healthy diets, using a range of computing software and culminating in a News style Interview to inform the rest of the School, how to eat and remain healthy.

**P.S.H.C.E and Geography:**

We will be looking at our understanding of other cultures and the diets they have and comparing these to our own. This will be largely linked with British Values, Science, Geography and our Topic work.

**Music:**

We will be studying the links between music and poetry. This half term will include looking at Pitch, Rhythm and Tone and how these can change the mood of music.

**Science:**

We are going to be looking at a range of materials, identifying their properties and predicting how and why they change state. This will involve our scientific enquiry mind-set, to study a material, recognise its properties, classify these properties, predict any change that may occur and to then test these theories by conducting a fair test.

We will also take part in some experiments and some of us will be hosting an afternoon of Science experiments for the whole School to take part in.


**R.E:**

**Maths:**

We will continue to look at a range of topics, in order to improve our understanding and quash any misconceptions.

We will focus on fractions and how these can be added, subtracted and multiplied. During this module we will investigate mixed numbers and improper fractions as wholes and parts. These will be converted in to both decimals and percentages and will also appear in word problems, of several steps.

The class will also look at comparing mental and written methods for solving problems and will highlight their preferred methods and the reasons why.

**English:**

This half term we will be looking at Classical Poetry. The children will be identifying language features, including expanded noun phrases, archaic language and lexical choice.

**Grammar and Punctuation:**

Revision of sub conjunctive verbs, past and present tense, adjectives, adverbs, clauses, expanded noun phrases, alliteration, similes, metaphors and subordinate clauses.
