This term we will be developing our ability to try new challenges and persist despite obstacles.

We are continuing to apply and foster a 'Growth Mind-set', to our approach to learning.

Our Exciting Curriculum

English

We will be learning and comparing stories about mini-beasts and using information books and the internet to find out more about the lifecycles of minibeasts and plants. We will also be learning to tell the story of Jack and Beanstalk with exciting actions and voices.

Phonics

We will be continuing to learn and embed the first 2 sets of sounds in order to apply these into our reading and writing.

Mathematics

We will be learning more about numbers including understanding that teen numbers have tens and units. We will be learning about odd and even numbers. We will learn more about telling the time on a clock and months of the year. We will be revising using money and will begin visiting the school snack bar later in the term. We will also be revising our adding and taking away skills and using them to help us solve problems.

Physical development, we will be learning all about keeping fit, eating healthily and playing a range of team games in the hall and on the field.

Communication and Language, we will be continuing to learn to speak in different tenses (past and present) and thinking about how we should speak to different audiences. We will be working on continuing to develop our vocabularies through our topic.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development, we will be making up our own game with rules during sports week and beginning to learn how to solve minor disagreements. We will also be learning to understand what bullying is.

Understanding the world, we will be learning about different creatures and mini-beasts including the lifecycle of some of these different creatures. We will also look at the life cycle of a seed and investigate how plants grow.

Creative Arts, we will be developing our own ideas to create, make and paint bugs and beasts. We will be creating giant minibeasts as a class too. We will be learning and developing our musical skills to play our own tunes and rhythms.

Religious Education, we will be learning about Pentecost and Our Wonderful World.
