# Marvellous Mayans

## **Maths**

We will be spending a week looking at line graphs and learning how to interpret tables and timetables, before moving on to a longer unit on decimals and percentages.

This half-term our learning will be blended: a combination of learning at home and in school. We shall be continuing with our Mayan theme.

## **English**

We shall continue to read our book *The Explorer* by Katherine Rundell but shall start a study of the poem *The Highwayman* by Alfred Noyes. We shall finish our term with some instruction

## **Spanish**

We will be finishing our work on clothes before moving on to wild animals. We will also learn about Easter and Carnival.

## **RE**

We will be learning about Humanism and what it means to be a Humanist.

## **PE**

We shall be keeping ourselves active doing a range of activities in school and at home.

## **History**

We will be continuing our study of the Mayan period and will be comparing how Mayans lived with how people lived in England between the 8th and 10th century.

## **Computing**

We will be learning about spreadsheets.

## **Design and Technology**

We will be thinking about what it means to eat healthily. We shall then research different types of salad before planning, making and evaluating our own.

## **Science**

We will be learning about Ecosystems: what they are; classifying diets of animals; food chains; and food webs.
